

## TRIPLE “T” QUILT



30 6x8” finished block (120) @ 6.5)

This block is **very easy** to production line piece. There are no seams to match until the rows are joined.

Make 30 sets of 3, 2.5x6.5” strips. Add a 2.5x6.5” strip to one end of each set to complete the block. Block should measure 6.5 x 8.5”.

**Join the blocks into rows**, following layout below. Press the joining seams of the odd numbered rows in the same direction. Press the even numbered rows in the opposite direction.

**Join the rows.** The joining seams should ‘snuggle’ if you have pressed correctly.

Join rows (1 & 2) (3, 4 & 5) Press the long joining seam as desired – up or down.

Join the 1,2 unit to the 3,4,5 unit & press.

**Add borders** – (kit may contain border fabric or cut border strips) Cut strips at 3.5”. Add to long sides – press toward the border. Add top & bottom border . Press toward the border.
