

Good Neighbors

Quilt has two blocks as pictured above. Batiks work well with this pattern.

This quilt is extremely easy to production line piece.

Three strips at 2.5 x 6.5 and two strips at 3.5 x 6.5

Construct 28 blocks of each type.

Blocks are assembled into rows as pictured below.

Press the joining seams of the odd numbered rows in one direction. Press the even numbered rows in the opposite direction. This guarantees that when the rows are joined the seams will “snuggle”.

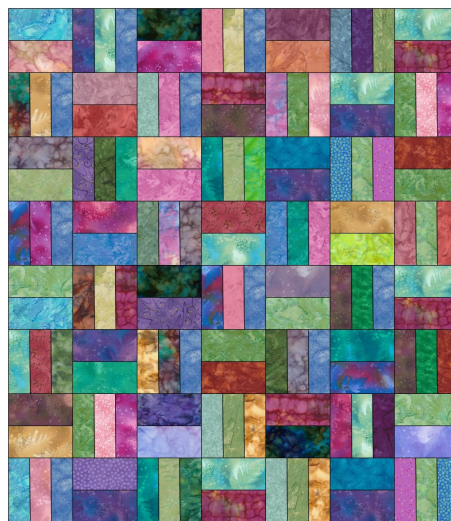
A suggestion for joining the rows. This method eliminates excessive handling of the quilt; pressing is easier.

Join rows (1 & 2) (3 & 4) (5 & 6) (7 & 8) Press the long joining seams as desired - up or down.

Join the 1,2 unit to the 3,4 unit and press the long joining seam. Join the 5,6 unit to the 7,8 unit and press the long joining seam.

Join the 1,2,3,4 unit and the 5,6,7,8 unit. Press
