

Seaside Piecemakers Quilt Show 2018

Entry forms for the 2018 Quilt Show are now being accepted! This year as a SSPM member the first quilt you enter is free and any quilt thereafter, up to three, there will be a charge of \$5.00 per quilt. You may mail your entry form or turn in at any General meeting at the Quilt Show table. All entry forms must be accompanied by a color 4X6 photo as well as payment of \$5.00 per quilt. For \$5.00 entry fee we will ONLY accept cash or checks. The quilt does not need to be totally completed prior to submitting the entry and photo.

Timeless Treasurers Quilt Show 2018 "Pieces of our Lives" Entry Requirements

This is a member ONLY show.

Ribbons – First, Second and Third may be awarded in each category listed, Except Display only. Ribbons for quilting will be given in separate awards. Honorable Mention ribbons may be awarded at the discretion of the Judge.

Special Awards- Best of Show, Best Hand Quilting, Best Stationary Machine Quilting, Best Longarm Machine Quilting, Judge's Recognition and Viewers Choice, Best First Time Quilter in Any Quilt Show.

All entries must be comprised of three layers and must be quilted, not tied. NO entry can exceed 112 inches in width.

Entries must have been completed after January 1, 2014 and may not have been entered in a previous Seaside Piecemakers Quilt Show. **All entries must be display ready, clean and free of odors, stains, pet hair, etc. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR SHOW ENTRY!**

Sleeve- All quilts wider than 20 inches must have a 4 inch wide sleeve (made from a 9 inch strip of fabric folded lengthwise) at the top on the back of the quilt. Both top and bottom of sleeve must be stitched to the quilt. On long quilts, the top of the sleeve must be no more than 90 inches from the bottom of the quilt.

Label- Each quilt must have a fabric identification label on the back with the owner's full name and the quilt name, preferably sewn on the lower left hand corner. Any reference to the quilt maker on the front of the quilt must be covered with hand- basted fabric.

Registration Form- One form per entry, no more than 3 entries and numbered 1-3, must be completed. Limited to **one quilt per category** may be entered. A 4X6 color photo must accompany each form. The item in the photo doesn't have to be finished but must be recognizable by color and pattern used. Photographs will not be returned. On the front of the photo the width and length must be stated and the back of the photo must have the quilter's name, the name of the quilt and the category it is being entered in with the order preference 1-3. **The first quilt entered will be free and the fee of \$5.00 will be charged for each quilt entered thereafter, up to the limit of three quilts. We can ONLY take cash or**

checks for payment of your entry fee. Please complete your entry forms online or mail to: Kathie Medley, 1330 Grand Cayman Drive, Merritt Island, FL 32952. **All photo's and \$5.00 entry fees must be turned in at a General Meeting or mailed to Kathie Medley.**

Storage- While the quilts are stored at the venue, they will be handled with great care. But we cannot be responsible for any special treatment or particular method of storage.

Exclusions- (NOT Accepted Entries) – NO whole embellished or partial quilted printed panels, framed or mounted quilts, purses, tied or un-quilted quilts, dolls, home décor items, (i.e. table runners, place mats, tree skirts, pillows and bed runners). All entries should be numbered in order of preference 1-3. If more quilts are entered than there is room to display, the quilts of lowest preference will be eliminated from this show. If the member wishes to inform the public that her item is for sale, a business size card will be attached to the item after the quilt is hung. This will be a private sale between the seller and the buyer. This sale is not connected to the Seaside Piecemakers Quilt Show.

***** 2018 CATEGORIES*****

100 DISPLAY ONLY: These quilts will NOT be judged.

200 PIECED: Piecing must be the dominant technique. Can be hand or machine quilted.

300 APPLIQUE, MACHINE: Machine appliqué must be dominant technique.

400 APPLIQUE, HAND: Hand appliqué must be the dominant technique.

500 MIXED TECHNIQUES: A quilt where 2 or more major construction techniques are used to develop the design of the top, (i.e. appliqué, piecing, trapunto, machine embroidery, silk ribbon embroidery and redworks not including quilting).

600 SMALL QUILTS: Quilt must be a small version of a full size quilt. Sum of all 4 sides cannot exceed 96 inches. Machine or hand quilted or both.

700 MODERN: Quilt that is inspired by modern design, often using improvisational piecing or appliqué and including bold high contrast colors with simple shapes on neutral backgrounds. Quilt may be quilted by hand, machine or both.

800 ORIGINAL DESIGN: Quilt must be quilter's original design. Any technique may be used but it must be 3 layers and quilted, NOT mounted.

900 SPECIAL TECHNIQUES: A quilt where one special technique is predominantly used to develop the design of the top such as whole cloth, cathedral window, crazy quilt, yoyo and biscuit. It may be a group quilt with 2 or more quilters.

Depending on the number of quilt entries in any category, it may be divided into small, medium and or large quilts.

----- **ADDITIONAL AWARDS** -----

This year we have added additional awards for **quilting ONLY**. A quilt entered in any category, may be held to be judged for a quilting award. The quilt may or may not be in ribbon contention for the category it was entered into at this show. First, Second and Third ribbons may be awarded in each of the following quilting types.

HAND QUILTED: Hand quilting must be the dominant technique.

HOME OR STATIONARY MACHINE QUILTED: The quilt must be quilted on home or stationary machine.

LONGARM MACHINE QUILTED: Quilt must be quilted on a longarm quilting machine.
