

MAGIC MITERED TABLE RUNNER

WOW - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards of one fabric - and you have a spectacular (and very impressive) table runner. Learn a few special techniques to make this quick and easy project. Any multicolored with large repeat striped fabric recommended - varying from light to dark & ranges of colors. Either vertical or selvedge to selvedge will work.

Warning - these are habit forming and will make great gifts.

Supplies:

- Sewing machine - all the parts and pieces necessary for functional use
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " Foot
- Neutral thread for piecing
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards striped material [see specifics of strip above] (front) - 42" wide
 - ✓ The more irregular the strip - the better
- 1 $\frac{1}{3}$ yard backing material
- Batting
- *Block Lock ruler or Tucker Trimmer- for trimming squares*
- Small personal cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" ruler - for cutting strips
- Marking pencil - chalk or Frixon pen - which ever shows best on your fabric
- Small iron and personal ironing pad (if desired)
- Pins
