(Community Service)
Kit contains:
100 light $21 / 2 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
100 dark $21 / 2 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
OR: 25 sets of 4 - identical dark fabrics 100 strips of light fabric

This is a random scrap quilt. Do not become "obsessed" with placing colors.
"Production line piece" a dark strip to each light strip. (unit) Press toward the dark.


Assemble the 2 strip units in rows following the layout in the picture below (10 rows) . OR make a 4 unit "spinning" block as pictured in the Variation below. Join the 4 unit blocks into rows... $5 \times 5$.


## VARIATION:

Make 4 units with the same dark fabric. Join into a 4 unit block.

You will need 25 sets of 4 dark fabrics and 100 strips
 of light fabric.

All strips are 2 1/2" x 4 1/2".

Design hint: If you want your blocks to appear to "float" add a small light border and then a darker, larger border.

A single dark border "ties" your blocks to the border.
